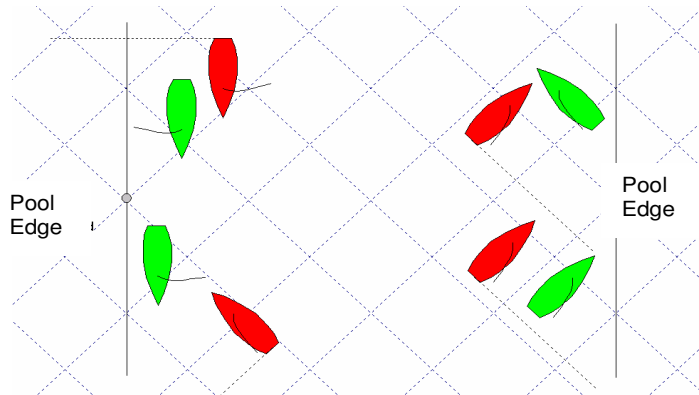
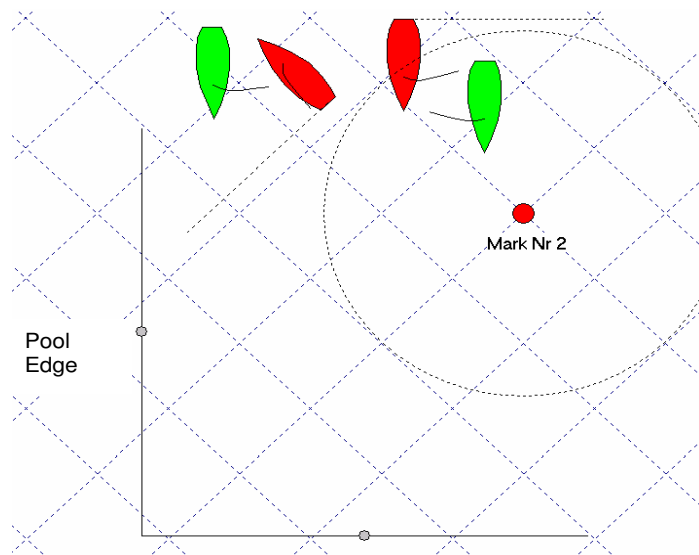


### Event Call 1



Within 1 boat length from the pool edge the inside overlapped boat has the right of way boat and the outside boat shall keep clear, the inside boat may tack or gybe.

### Event Call 2

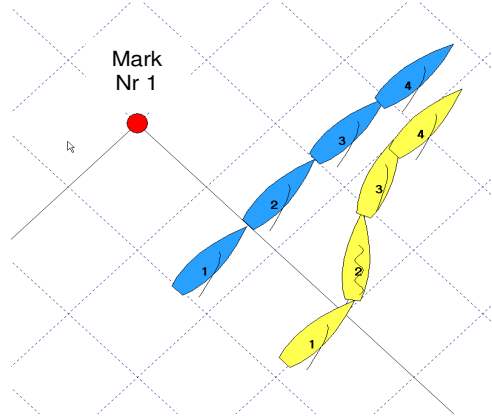


Rule 18 applies; the marks will be at least 3 boat lengths from the pool edge

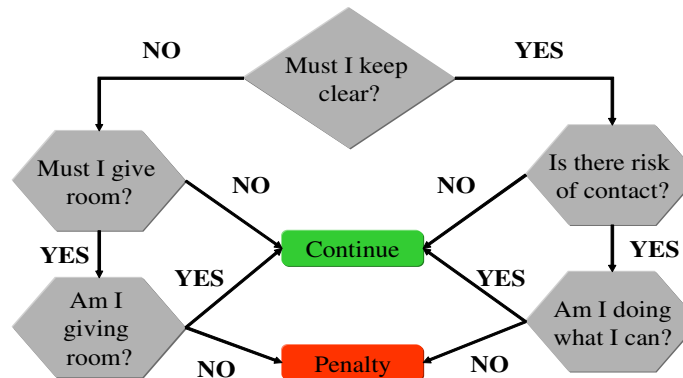
### Event Call 3

Yellow (Y) and blue (B) on close-hauled course on port tack approaching the layline near the mark 1.

When Y luffs its clear that her proper course is to luff in order to tack toward the mark. Y give B room as required by rule 16.1. But Y is unable to sail her proper course, as B breaks rule 11. Penalty for B.

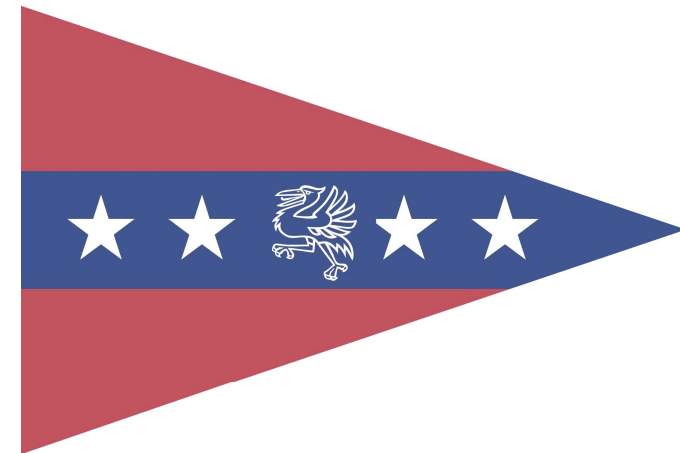

## Racing Rules *(see also Event Calls)*

- Usual right of way rules apply and appendix C
- All penalties are umpire initiated
- Umpire decision is final. No protest hearings and appeals.
- Within 1 boat length of the pool edge, the inside overlapped boat has right of way and other boat shall keep clear
- Boat with penalty must as soon as reasonable possible:
  - on the run, complete a tack and bear away to a downwind course
  - on the beat, gybe and luff to the close hauled course
- All pre-start penalties must be taken immediately after start. No penalty should be taken within the 2 lengths zone of rounding mark 1 or 2
- A boat with 3 outstanding penalties will be black flagged and the match assigned to the opponent
- No sculling (Rule 42)
- For Repechage and Qualification, the Ski ranking determines which boat (yellow or red) is allocated for each team. Otherwise boat allocation is determined by coin toss. Swap boats every odd match. See number of matches and laps below.
- Start sequence:
  - 60 seconds:** countdown starts, boats released from respective dock, and sail
  - At **40 seconds** boat must be on the assigned and behind the vertical line, at **30 seconds** boats must have crossed starting line from windward. Otherwise penalty.
  - 0 seconds,** start.
- No request for repair or re-sail will be granted after 40 seconds start countdown.

## Number of Matches and Laps

Repechage: Best of 1 Match, 1 Lap

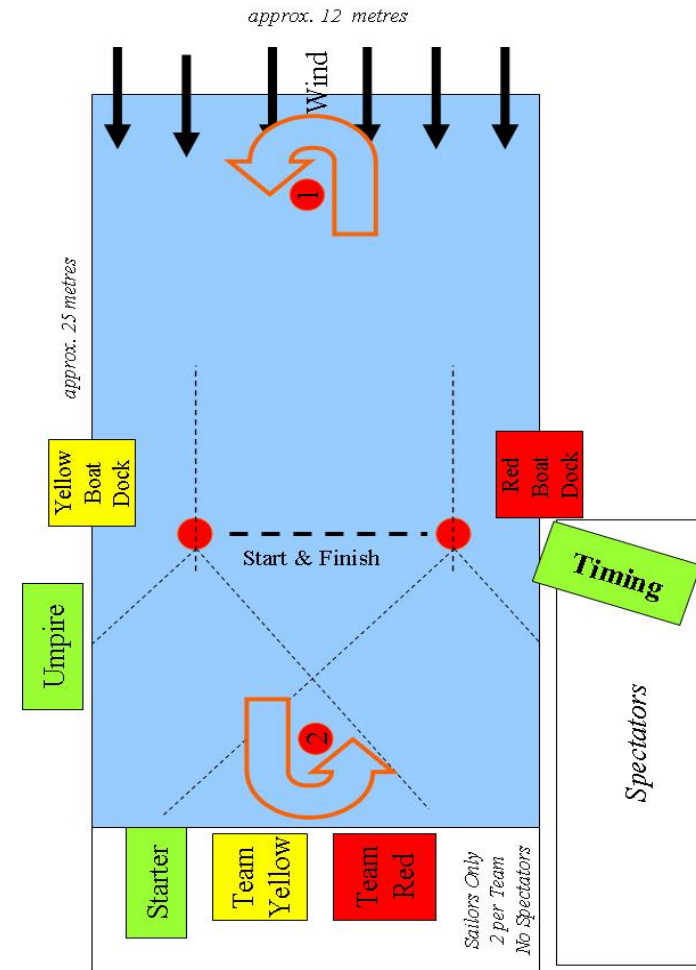
Qualifying: Best of 1 Match, 2 Laps

Quarter Finals: Best of 3 Matches, 1 Lap

Semi Finals: Best of 3 Matches, 1 Lap

Final: Best of 3 Matches, 2 Laps *(tbd)*
